## COMPLAINTS & DISCIPLINE GUIDELINES

---

### (1) Registrar Complaints

- Any complaints that a registrar has should firstly be brought to the attention of their supervisor. **This includes conflict with other registrars.**
- If not dealt with to the satisfaction of the registrar then direct application to the ACPS council can be made. Specific complaints from registrars regarding their respective supervision will be accepted at any time.

### (2) Registrar Discipline

- Registrars will receive three written warnings of inappropriate behaviour from a supervisor.
  - Further infringement will result in referral to ACPS council with recommendation for 6-months suspension of training of respective registrar.
  - Should the occasion arise, a second suspension can be recommended to the ACPS council without the requirement of another three written warnings. If accepted by the ACPS council, the training of the respective registrar will be discontinued.
